

Criterion 2.7: Student Satisfaction Survey

Introduction

As part of the NAAC accreditation process and in compliance with Criterion 2.7, the institute conducted a **Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS)** to evaluate the effectiveness of the teaching-learning process and overall institutional performance. The survey was managed using the **VM Edulife software**, ensuring a streamlined and efficient feedback collection process.

Feedback Collection Methodology

- 1. Platform Used:** Feedback was gathered using the **VM Edulife software**, providing a secure and user-friendly interface for students.
- 2. Participants:** Students from **Final Year B. Pharm** and **M. Pharm** were invited to participate.
- 3. Survey Parameters:** The feedback form included 21 key parameters, focusing on:
 - Quality of teaching and course delivery.
 - Use of ICT tools in classroom instruction.
 - Infrastructure, library, and learning resources.
 - Opportunities for skill development and career guidance.
 - Examination and evaluation process.
- 4. Rating Scale:** A **5-point Likert scale** was used to evaluate each parameter (0-Poor, 1 - Average, 2 - Good, 3 -Very Good, 4 - Excellent).
- 5. Response Collection:** The software enabled automated data collection, ensuring accuracy and efficiency.


Data Analysis Using VM Software

- **Score Compilation:** VM software generated automated reports, including the average score and standard deviation for each parameter.
- **Overall Satisfaction:** The software calculated an aggregate satisfaction percentage across all surveyed students.
- **Real-Time Insights:** Graphical reports and charts provided by the software offered a clear understanding of strengths and areas for improvement.

Key Findings

- 1. Strengths Identified:**
 - Students appreciated the effective use of ICT-enabled tools (PPTs, videos).

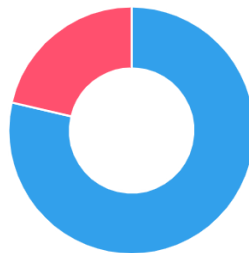
