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POLICY FOR MANAGEMENT OF SICK STUDENTS DURING LECTURE AND PRACTICAL SESSIONS

1. Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to ensure prompt, responsible, and safe assistance to any student who becomes sick or requires immediate medical attention during a lecture, practical, or other academic activity conducted within the college premises.

2. Responsibility of the Concerned Teacher

1. It shall be the **primary responsibility of the concerned teacher** conducting the lecture/practical to look after the sick student and ensure that the student receives timely medical attention.
2. The teacher shall assess the situation and immediately arrange for the student to be shifted to the designated hospital whenever required.
3. The teacher shall not leave the sick student unattended until appropriate arrangements for medical care have been made.

3. Arrangement of College Vehicle

1. The concerned teacher shall immediately contact the **Transport Department** to arrange the college vehicle for shifting the sick student to the hospital.
2. The teacher shall contact:
 - **Mr. Bhosale, Transport Department: 8275200520**
 - **Alternatively, Dr. Ramesh Shinde Sir: 9404695242**
3. The college vehicle shall be arranged at the earliest possible time depending upon the availability of the vehicle.

4. Designated Hospital

1. The sick student shall be taken to **Dr. Lad's Matoshri Hospital, Kashti** for medical attention.
2. The student shall be accompanied by the **concerned teacher and laboratory assistant**, as applicable.
3. The concerned teacher shall ensure that the student safely reaches the hospital and is handed over to the medical staff/appropriate attendant.



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5. Communication with Parents/Guardians

1. The concerned teacher shall **immediately contact the student's parent/guardian** after reaching the hospital.
2. The parent/guardian shall be informed about the student's condition and the medical assistance being provided.
3. The teacher shall remain at the hospital until the student's parent/guardian arrives or appropriate responsibility for the student has been taken over.

6. Responsibility After Handover

1. After the student's parent/guardian arrives at the hospital and takes responsibility for the student, the concerned teacher and laboratory assistant may leave the hospital.
2. The college staff shall not be responsible for remaining at the hospital after the student has been formally handed over to the parent/guardian.

7. Medical and Other Expenses

1. All medical, transportation, treatment, investigation, medicine, hospitalization, and other expenses related to the student's treatment shall be borne by the student's parent/guardian.
2. The college shall facilitate transportation and immediate assistance but shall not be responsible for the student's medical expenses.

8. Emergency Situations

In case of a serious or life-threatening emergency, the concerned teacher shall prioritize the student's immediate safety and medical treatment and take all reasonable steps necessary to obtain urgent medical assistance without waiting for completion of routine formalities.

9. Compliance

All teaching and laboratory staff shall strictly follow this policy whenever a student becomes sick during a lecture, practical, or other academic activity.
