Policy for Proposal Presentation

M. Pharm Semester IV

1. Objective

The objective of the proposal presentation is to assess the student's ability to conceptualize, design, and present a research project effectively. It also ensures readiness for dissertation work through critical evaluation by faculty members.

2. Applicability

This policy is applicable to all **M. Pharm Semester IV students** and **teaching faculty** involved in guiding and evaluating research proposals.

3. Proposal Submission Guidelines

- Students must submit a **typed research proposal** duly approved by their guide at least **7 days prior** to the presentation.
- The proposal should include:
 - Title of the research work
 - Introduction and literature review
 - Objectives of the study
 - Research methodology
 - Expected outcomes
 - References

4. Presentation Guidelines

- Each student will be allotted:
 - **15 minutes for presentation**
 - **10 minutes for discussion/viva**
- Presentation should be prepared using **PowerPoint (PPT)**.
- Students must maintain **formal dress code and discipline** during presentation.
